Young People are at the heart of all our work.


Our primary means of reaching and engaging Young People is 'Detached' Youth Work – spending time with them on the street corner, car park or wherever they want to 'hang out'


This is complemented by working within schools – which improves contacts, 'street cred' – and credibility with many other agencies.
